2. [Flash Software V15](#)

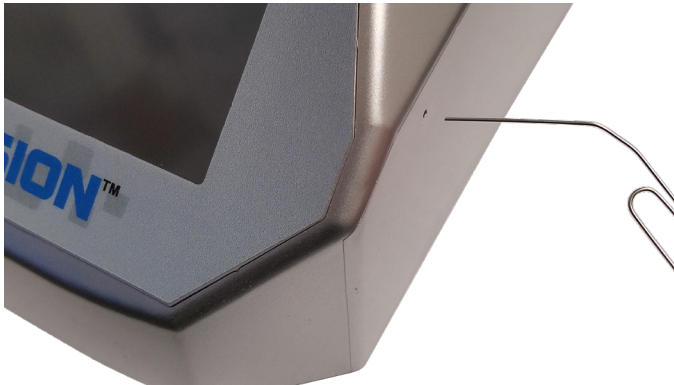

CAUTION: Detach power cord before proceeding

Remove the Touch Screen Controller

Insert the Paper Clip into the small hole on either side of the housing.



Repeat the process on the other side of the housing

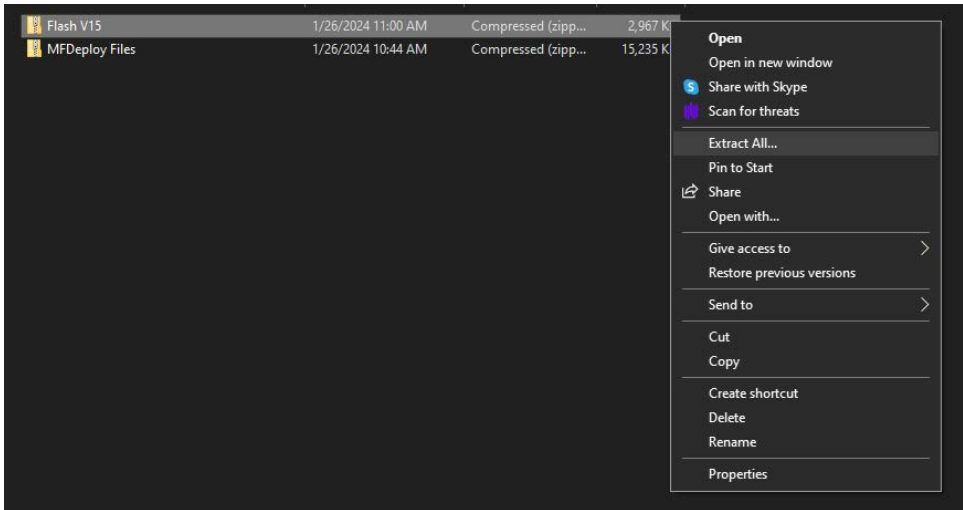


Press in paper clip until two clicks are heard: The first click releases the controller bezel and the second click ejects it from the housing as shown.

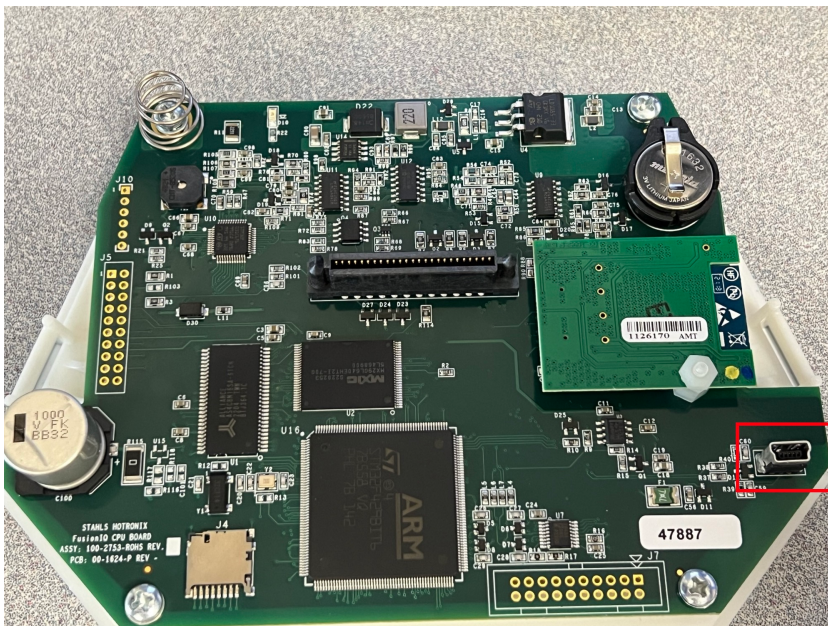

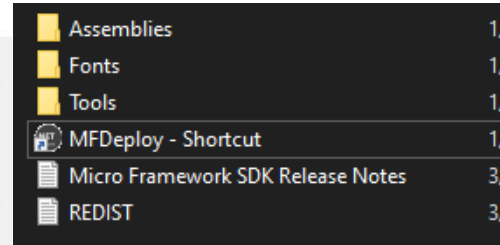
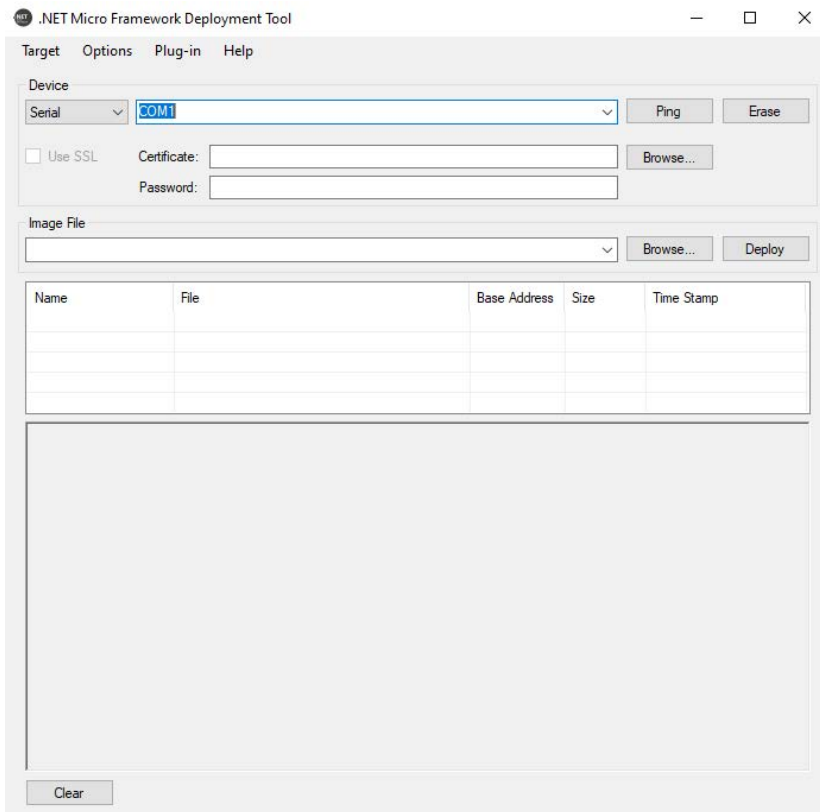




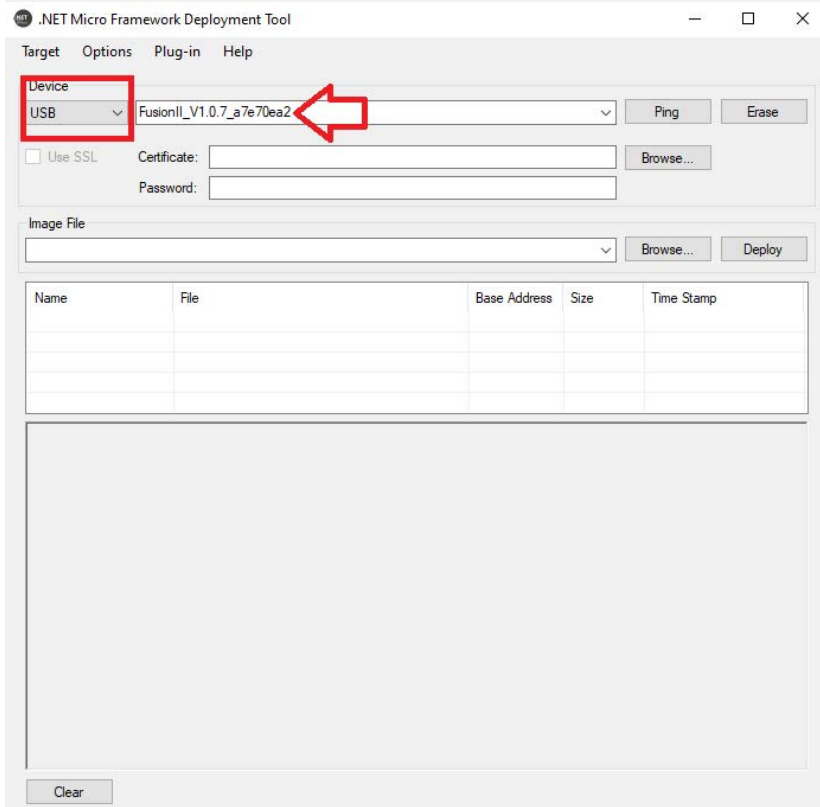
Moving to your computer, extract files from download links above. They will not function as a ZIP file.



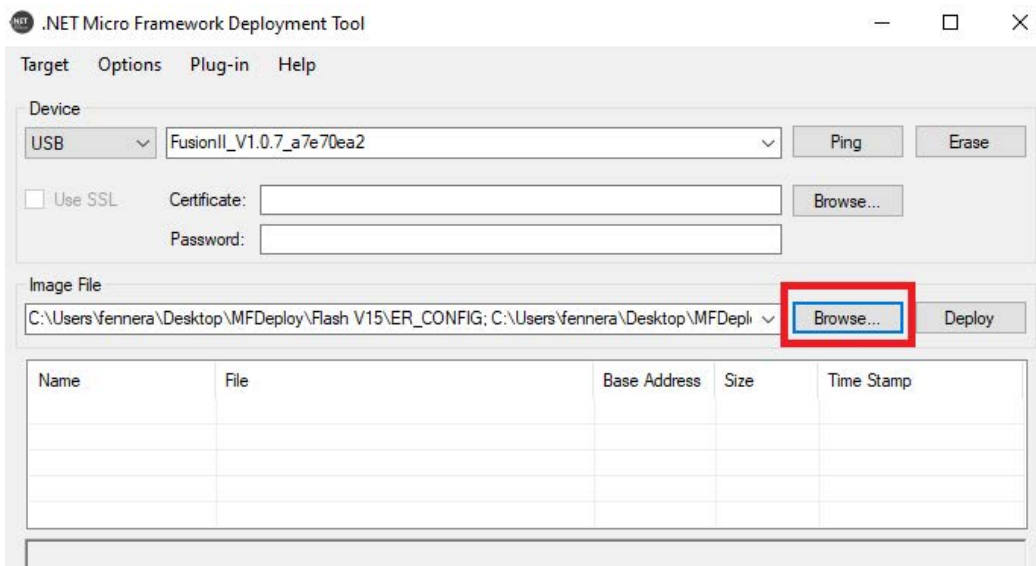
Locate the mini-usb port on the back of the faceboard and connect it with your computer.



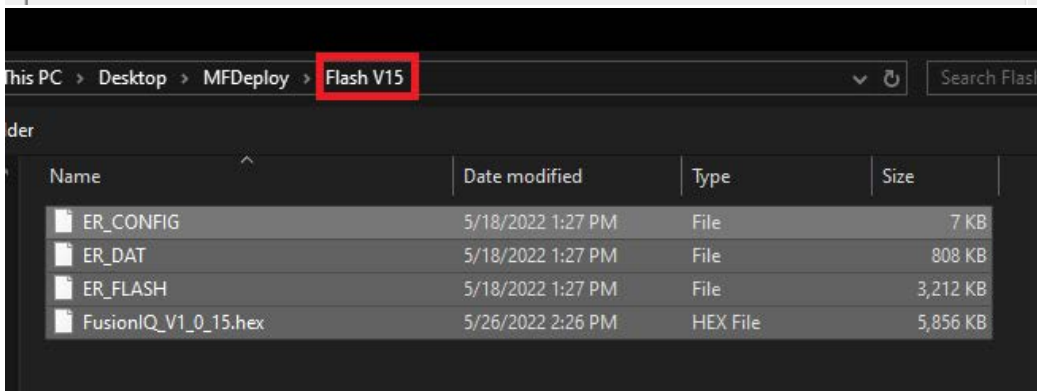
Locate where you extracted the zipped folders, open MFDeploy Files and then run MFDeploy - Shortcut. Once open, it will display this window.



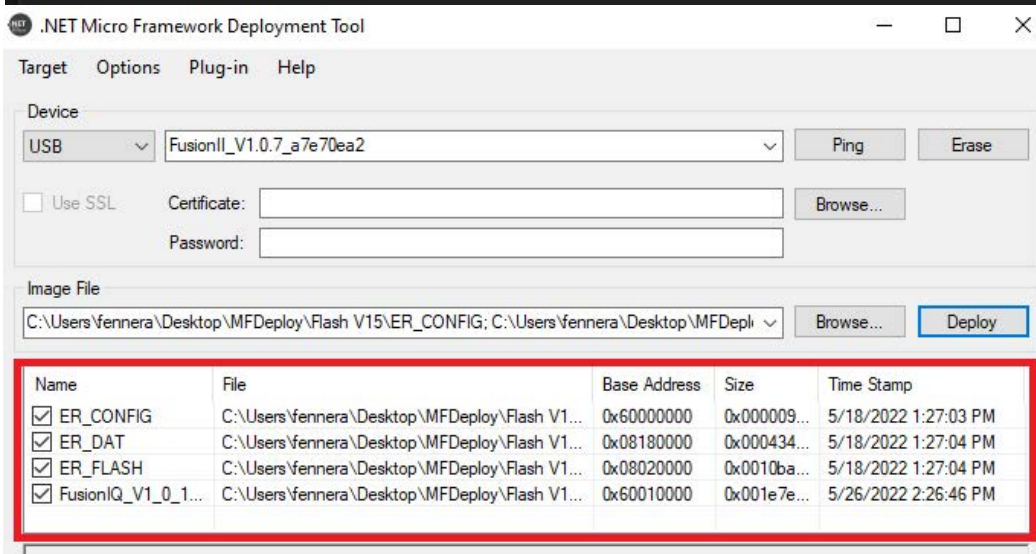
Click the drop-down arrow in the device section and select USB. Your device should now be detected by the tool.



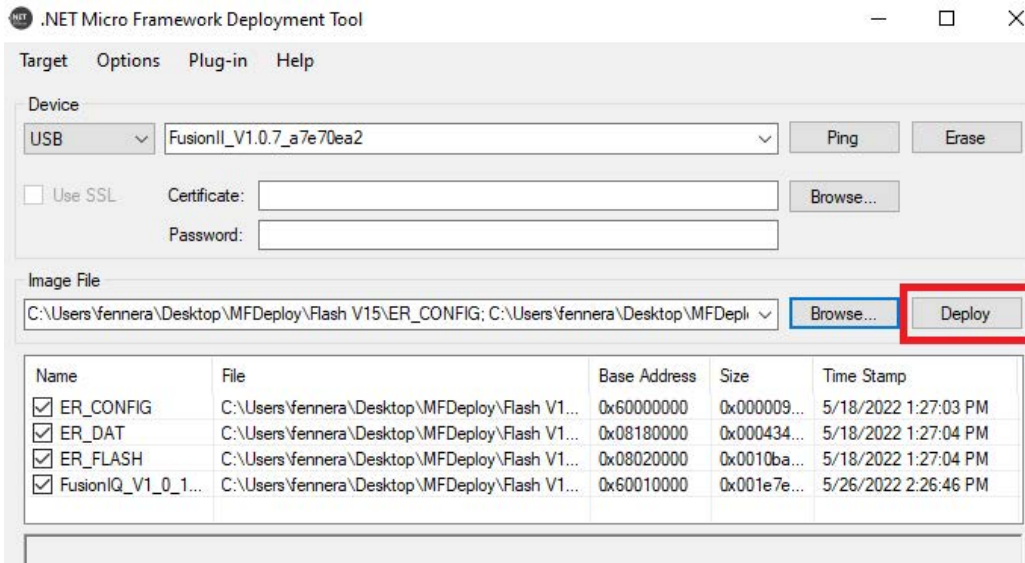
Click browse and then locate your Flash V15 folder files.



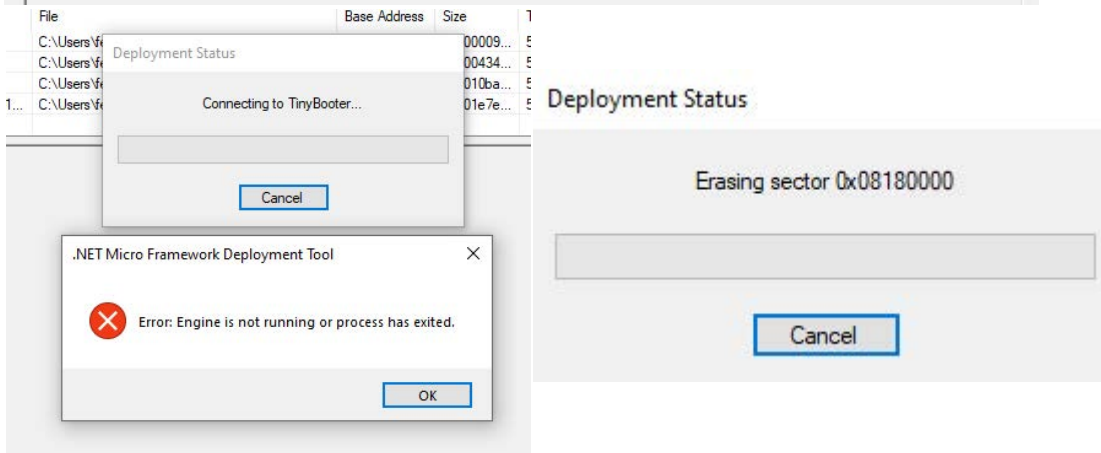
Select all of these files and then open them.



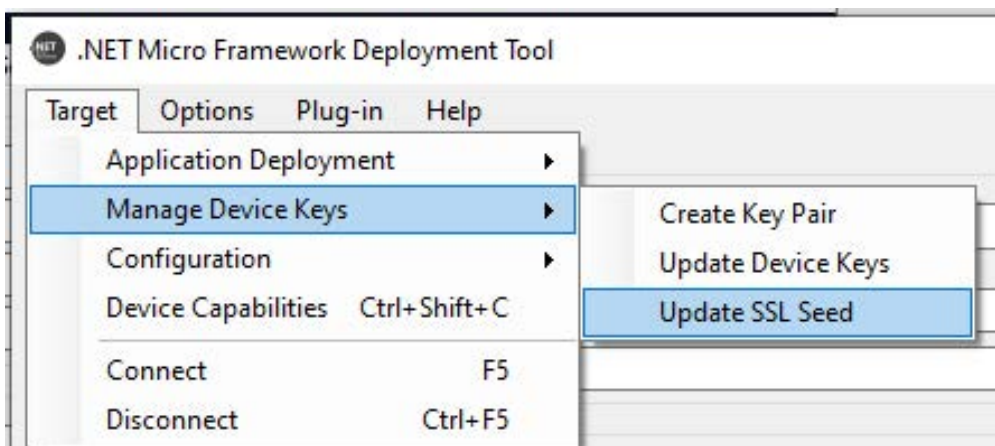
This section should now have these files active.



Click Deploy and the program will attempt to execute this action. It will fail the first time you run this, showing an error.



Try again and it will begin deploying the program. This will take a few minutes.



Once that has finished, update the SSL seed a few times to ensure it goes through. This is necessary for the press to have a wifi connection.

Return face board to the press and test to confirm functionality.
